Water and liquids from food products often contain bacteria. Unlike natural stones, Spectrum Quartz is nonporous and does not absorb water.

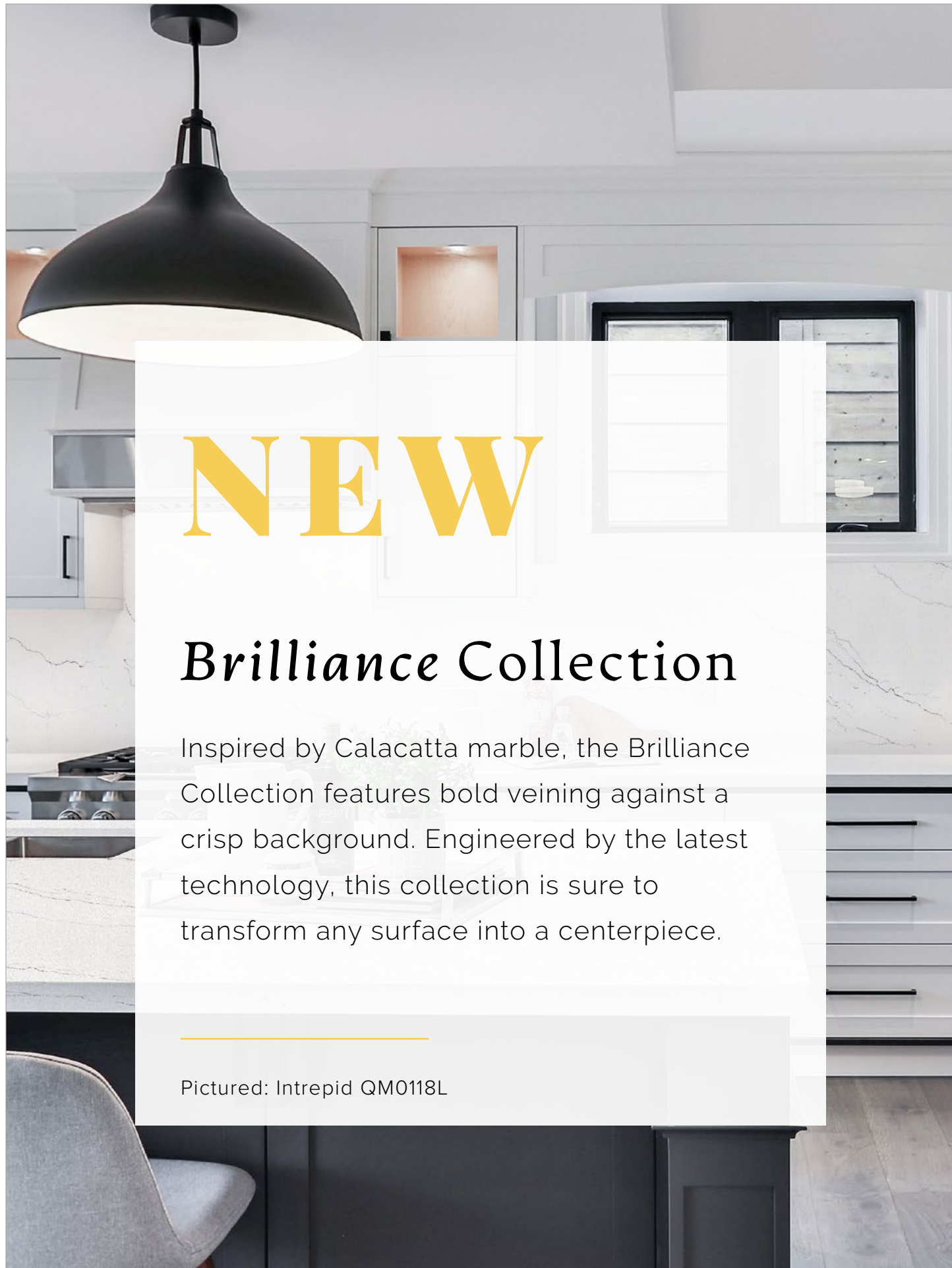

Viewing a physical sample is highly recommended prior to purchasing.** Samples are a small section of the actual product and cannot fully convey the movement and visual aesthetics of an installed product. It is highly suggested to visit SpectrumQuartz.com to view the appearance of a large slab prior to purchase. **The Brilliance and Elegance Collections have especially large scale, random movement and veining that may not be visible from a smaller sample. Slabs of these collections will vary from one to the next and that randomness is intended.**

Care & Maintenance

Spectrum Quartz is non-porous and does not absorb liquids that can stain and harbor bacteria. As a result, cleaning and maintaining your Spectrum Quartz surface is easy.

- Using a damp, non-abrasive cloth or soft sponge, wipe the surface to remove any debris or materials on the surface.
- You may use a mild soap or detergent. Be sure not to use any abrasive cleaning products.
- For difficult spots, soak the area first using a wet cloth or paper towels and warm water for 10 minutes.
- If an object is stuck, use a plastic putty knife to gently scrape the object off the surface.
- Dry the surface completely after cleaning.

Spectrum Quartz is very durable. However, no surface is chip or damage proof. Proper care and simple cleaning can help your surface last for many years to come.

- Always use a cutting board when cutting and do not use knives directly on the surface.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning products as these may damage the surface.
- Do not expose Spectrum Quartz to harsh chemicals such as acetone, bleach, concentrated acids, oven or drain cleaners, or highly alkaline chemicals.
- Spectrum Quartz can be damaged by sudden and extreme temperature changes. Do not place hot pots, pans, stoneware, or other objects onto the surface directly. Use a trivet or hot pad.
